Will of Ophelia G. Royal.

By virtue of the fact that I, Ophelia G. Royal, being of sound mind and memory and knowing the incertainty of life, do make this my last will and testament.

1st- After my death, I desire that all my just debts be paid.

2nd- I, hereby, do will and bequeath that after my death, that all my property of whatever kind, whether real estate, or personalty or money be given to my sisters, Joanna J. and Medora O. Royal, in case both of them survive, otherwise to the survivor.

3rd- In case I survive both of my sisters, above named, then I wish after my death, that all my property be sold and the money divided equally between my brother, I. N. Royal, and my sister, Corinne Waite, or their children if they do not survive, and the children of my ~~sixth~~ sister, Nettie Brown, deceased-

4th- I appoint my brother, I. N. Royal as Executor to this my last will and testament- In testimony whereof, I, Ophelia G. Royal hereto affix my hand and seal, this Aug. 22-1910.
