Gordon received Sixty-Dollars

Item 3 I hereby constitute and appoint my Son G. C. Morrison Executor of this my last will and testament - this the 30 day of November 1885 Andrew Morrison signed ~~declared~~ and published by Andrew Morrison as his last will and testament in the presence of us the Subscribers who Subscribed our names hereto in the presence of said Testator at his instance and request and of each other he signed in our presence and we signed in his presence
