 depart this life deem it right and proper both  
 as respects my family and myself that I should  
 make a disposition of the property with which a  
 kind Providence has blessed me, I do  
 therefore make this my last Will and Testament  
 hereby revoking and annulling all others by  
 me heretofore made.

First } I desire that my Body be buried in a  
 decent Christianlike manner suitable to my  
 circumstances and condition in life. My  
 Soul I trust shall return to rest with God who  
 gave it - as I hope for salvation through the  
 merits and atonement of the blessed and Saviour  
 Jesus Christ

Secondly } I desire and direct that all my just debts  
 be paid without delay by my executors herein  
 after named and appointed

Thirdly } I give bequeath and devise to my beloved  
 wife a certain lot of land number Three hund-  
 red and five and three hundred and eight  
 except a small portion in the South West Corner  
 of said lot that has been added to James Cotton  
 both of said lots of land lying and being in  
 the twenty fourth District and second section  
 Pickens County containing three hundred and  
 fifteen acres more or less with all the right  
 members and appurtenances to said lots of  
 land in anywise belonging free from all  
 charge and limitation to her own proper  
 use benefit behoof during her natural  
 life And of the residue of my beloved wife

It is my will and desire that there be an equal distribution made of all my effects among my Children without partiality.

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife One White Horse, one wagon, one Yoke of Oxen, two Cows and Calves, Eight head of pork Hogs and all my stock Hogs without any reserve. I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife all my house-hold and Kitchen Furniture with all the Farming utensils on my said Farm all without limitation or reserve.

Fifthly, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife My entire Stock of Sheep.

Sixthly, I hereby constitute my beloved wife Ann Bradley Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.
