
State of Georgia, In the Name of God Amen, I

that I must shortly depart this life deems
it right and proper both as respects my family
and myself that I should make a disposition
of the property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me with, I do therefore make this
My last will and Testament hereby revoking
and revoking all others by me heretofore made.
First I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent Christian like manner suitable to
my circumstances and condition in life My
soul I trust shall return to rest with God
who gave it as I hope for salvation through
the merits and atonement of the blessed
Lord and savior Jesus Christ
Secondly I desire and direct that all my
just debts be paid without delay by my
Executor herein after named and
appointed,
Thirdly give legateath and devise to my
beloved wife Elizabeth M Fifty five Acres
of land it being part of lot number thirty
Seven in the thirteenth West and second
section and half of the general or lot
No Eleven hundred and forty and all
the mineral in nine hundred and
ninety six in the 4th East and 1st section in
Dawson County with all the rights
members and appurtenances to said land in
any case belonging free from all charge and
limitation whatever to her own proper use
benefit and pleasure during her life time

or widow hood I also give and bequeath
to my beloved wife in the same intreserved
manner the farming utensals used
and belonging to the farm and said
land, and all my house hold and kitchen
furniture with exception of 3 beds and bed
clothes to go to the Barrett's to D M Barrett and
one to G P Barrett and all my horses cattle and
Cattle and Hogs Wagons and all the meat
lard and Corn fodder stacks and the
growing Crops if they should be any and
all the Cotton to go to my loving wife and
my books and all money notes and accounts
and goods, D M Barrett to have my rifle gun
Fowling P. I give and bequeath to my sons and
daughters R M Barrett and W G Barrett
and J H Barrett and M H Barrett and I
M Barrett and L C Barrett and J P Barrett
and Mrs L J Beardin all to have one
hundred Dollars only R M Barrett who
has already had one hundred Dollars
the advantage of rest, and when the rest
gets up to that then the said R M Barrett to
share with the rest R M Barrett R M Barrett
has one hundred Dollars ~~and~~ off land and
money more than any of the rest of the
children.

Fifthly I hold a note on J H Barrett for \$31.50
with the interest from date and I am security
on a note to T B Shockley for \$28,100⁰⁰ with
interest and if this is not paid it to come out
of his part of my estate first, and H H
Barrett has ten Dollars the advantage of the
rest of the

marry she can claim a part
Eighth³ I hereby constitute and appoint
my sons J H Barrett and D M Barrett
executors of my last will and
