and my self that I should make a disposition of
the property with which a kind providence has
blessed me do therefore make this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made
by me.

1st Item I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition in life
my soul I trust shall return to rest with God
who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation through
the merits and atonement of the blessed lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have
professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed for
thirty four years

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by my Executors here-
inafter appointed as I am unwilling my cred-
itors should be delayed in their rights especially
as there is no necessity for delay

3rd Item I Give and bequeath and devise
to my daughter Lousia part of lot of
land number one hundred and eighty nine
containing one hundred and fifteen acres
more or less and part of lot of land
number two hundred and eight containing
25 twenty five acres more or less in the
thirteenth Dist and Second Sect of Pickens
County Ga to have said land and

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the property her lifetime or while she
remains unmarried at such time
as either should take place then said
land to be sold and equally divided with
all my lawful heirs also
my house hold and kitchen
furniture to be her property to use as
she please with it. All other property
to be sold and equally divided with
my heirs

I hereby constitute and appoint my
son John King and my Son in Law
A W Johnson Executors of this my
last will and testament. This 28th June 1878
