make a disposition of the property with a kind Providence
has blessed me, I do therefore make this my will and
testament hereby revoking and annulling all
other by hear made,

First) I desire and direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter
named and appointed

Secondly, I give and devise that my beloved wife
Charity Thomas half of lot of land No (68) in the
thirteenth District and second section of Pickens
County contains 80 Acres more or less and all
the house hold and kitchen furniture to
raise my children on and also all my
stock of Cattle and hogs during her widowhood
and at her death or intermarriage the property to
be divided between my lawful heirs Equally

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I hereby constitute and appoint my
 wife ^{for} Charity Thomas my executrix of this my
 last Will and Testament This May 9th 1862
 signed sealed and ~~subscribed~~ ^{signed} by Elijah
 Thomas as his last will and Testament in presence
 of the undersigned who subscribed our
 names hereto in presence of said Testator
 at his special instance and request and in
 presence of each other This May the 9th 1862
