I Ephraim Davis of said

advanced age, and knowing that
I must shortly depart this life
do here in right and proper, both

as respects myself and family, I should make a
disposition of the property, with which a kind
providence has blessed me, do therefore make this
my last will and testament, hereby revoking all
others heretofore made by me.

1st Item, I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and a Christian like manner,
suitable to my circumstances, and condition in life.
My soul I trust shall return to rest with God,
who gave it

2nd Item, I desire and direct, that all my just debts
be paid, without delay, by my Executors hereinafter
appointed, as I am unwilling my creditors should
be delayed in their rights, especially as there is no necessity
for delay

3rd Item, I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved
wife Cassa, with whom I lived in the strictest
quiet for upwards of 40 years, for and during her
natural life (and) all my home hold and kitchen
furniture, all my hogs, Sheep, Cattle, and Horses, and
all my notes, accounts, and money, and all my estate
both real and personal,

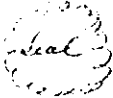
4th Item, The residue of my property, both real

is over)

my Executors of this my last Will and
Testament
