 peace during our marriage Lots of lands etc 114
 - 139 and ninety Acres of lot etc 115 being
 four hundred and ten acres more or less
 lying and being in the fifth District and
 Second of said County with all the rights
 members and appertinances in and
 belonging to Pickens County, Ga 1854 to hold and

enjoy all the issues and profits arising from the same during her life or widowhood and also all my personal property horses & mules oxen Cows hogs sheep wagons Carriages Corn wheat Rice oats faddles &c together with all notes accounts money and demands of every description is given to her my wife Hannah in the same unreserved manner with full power as one of my executors to bring to sale any personal property that she may not need for her support and the money arising from said sale to be equally divided among her my wife Hannah and the children giving James & Timmons and James Southard one half of their mothers portion and the remainder of their mothers portion I desire should go to them and the heirs of their body.

Item 4th I desire and direct that all my property both real and personalty whatever and whenever it may be at the death or second marriage of my wife Hannah be brought to sale by my Executor and executors and the money arising from said sale to be equally divided among all my children giving James & Timmons and James Southard one half of their mothers portion and the remainder of their mothers portion to go to them and the heirs of their body also all money notes open accounts that my wife may have on hand at her death or 2d marriage to be equally divided among all my children as mentioned in the foregoing Item.
