 139 and ninety Acres of lot ex 114 being
 four hundred and ten acres more or less
 lying and being in the fifth District and
 Second of said County with all the rights
 members and appurtenances in any way

my personal property horses & bullocks & cows & hogs
sheep & mares Carriages & corn & wheat & rice & oats & faddles
&c together with all notes accounts money and
demands of every description is given to her my wife

power as one of my executrix to bring to sale any
personal property that she may not need for her
support and the money arising from said sale
to be equally divided among her my wife Hannah
and the children after giving James & Kimons
and James & Southard one half of their mothers
portion and the remainder of their mothers portion
I desire should go to them and the heirs of their
body

Item 4th I desire and direct that all my
property both real and personally what
ever and wherever it may be at the death
or second marriage of my wife Hannah
be brought to sale by my Executors and
executrix and the money arising from
said sale to be equally divided among
all my children giving James & Kimons
and James & Southard one half of their
mothers portion and the remainder of
their mothers portion to go to them and the
heirs of their body also all money notes
open accounts that my wife may have
on hand at her death or 2nd marriage to be
equally divided among all my children as
