 and expenses be in the first place paid
 by my Executor Willis West out of my
 personal property that he may think best.

3rd I will and advise unto my lovely wife Mary
 My lot or parcel of land situated lying and
 being in the twelfth district of the Second
 Section of Calmer known by lot of land
 Number 233, being the north half of the
 aforesaid lot of land containing eighty
 acres during her natural life.

4th I will and give to my lovely wife Mary
 for and during her natural life all my
 personal property, house hold and kitchen
 furniture that remains after my debts
 are paid.

5th I will and advise immediately after the death
 of my lovely wife Mary that my executor
 Willis West proceed to sell the aforesaid
 parcel of land and all that remains
 together with the ^{success of the} aforesaid personal
 property, house hold and kitchen
 furniture and that all the money arising
 from the sale of the property be equally divided
 between my two sons, to-wit, Jacob H. H. H.
 Son of G. R. H. H. and Jacob A. West.
