 delay by My executor herein after named and  
 appointed.

Thirdly  
 I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife  
 Mary Mazilla the north half of lot of land number  
 seventy four in the 13<sup>th</sup> dist. & 2<sup>nd</sup> Sect. containing  
 eighty acres also the South half of lot of  
 land number Seventy two in the 13<sup>th</sup> dist.  
 & second Section containing eighty acres  
 also Seventy five acres (75) in the south  
 west corner of lot of land number  
 Seventy one (71) in the 13<sup>th</sup> dist. & 2<sup>nd</sup> Sect.  
 all in the County of Pickens & State of  
 Georgia in the following lots to numbers

and appurtenances to said parts of  
lots of land in anywise belonging free from  
all charge and limitation whatever to  
her own proper use benefit and behoof  
forever with full power to dispose of the  
same by will or otherwise as she may  
deem proper. I also give and bequeath  
to my beloved wife in the same un-  
reserved manner the farming utensils  
used on and belonging to the farm  
also all my livestock including one  
horse cattle hogs sheep and all my  
household and kitchen furniture, also  
all of my corn & provision of all  
kinds and all other property belonging  
to me not herein enumerated all with  
limitation or reserve, further,

I hereby constitute and appoint  
my friends James H. Corbin and  
A. R. Forbes Executors of this my  
last will and testament. This 7<sup>th</sup> day of December  
1880.
