 enjoyed for fifty seven years, And I desire my
 Body Buried in the Grave yard at the Methodist
 Church at Jasper near my Brother Robert, and my
 worldly Estate, I dispose of as follows.

First } I desire and direct that all my just debts be
 paid by my executor herein after named and appoin-
 ted unnecessary delay.

second } I give bequeath and devise to my beloved
 wife, Cynthia with whom I have lived in
 love fifty one years, all of my horses, mules, oxen
 cows, Calves, Sheep hogs, Poultry, house hold
 and Kitchen Furniture Money Notes accounts
 and personal property, that I am seized and
 possessed of. For and during her natural life
 to fully controul, dispose of as she may think proper
 for her soul and desperate use during her natural
 life And whatever of the above property that is not
 disposed of during her life to be equally divided
 among my children to wit Joseph A. Nancy Alfred
 Robert B. John S. Jane Bogeman David's children
 James' children Cynthia A. Dobbs

 son R B McCutchen Executor of this
