 a disposition of ~~my~~ property, with which a kind
 providence has blessed me, while I of sound disposing
 mind and memory - do therefore make this my last
 Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all
 others heretofore made by me,

Item 1st } I desire and direct that my body be buried
 in a decent christian like manner my soul, I trust,
 will return to rest with God who gave it, as I trust
 alone for salvation in the merits of the Attainment
 of the blessed Saviour Jesus Christ. (Item 2nd comes after Item 3rd)

Item 3rd } I give bequeath and devise to my beloved
 wife Delilah, with whom I have lived for a number
 of years in peace, The following described Lands during
 her natural life or widowhood, Lot of Land Number
 (214) Two hundred and fourteen, (219) Two hundred and
 nineteen, (183) One hundred and eighty three, and
 five acres of (218) Two hundred and eighteen, being
 five rods wide along on the East line of said
 lot, and Two acres more or less of Lot number (250)
 Two hundred and fifty on North-West side of the
 Creek described in a deed from Samuel Tate
 to S. Taburiaux, all of said lands being in the
 fifth district and second section of said County,
 I, also, give, bequeath and devise to my beloved wife
 + during her natural life, or widowhood, all of my stock
 to-wit: Horses, Cows, Calves, oxen, sheep, hogs, wagons,
 farming and mechanical tools, Corn, fodder, meat
 and provisions of every kind House-hold and kitchen
 furniture all the above given to her for the
 use of ~~myself~~ my minor children

And I direct that such of our minor children as remain single have a home with her on the premises to be raised, maintained and schooled out of the proceeds and at her death or marriage, then all the property herein given to my said wife be equally divided amongst my children by her to-wit: Mary E Fann Hester & Norton Barbary Taburians. Elias Taburians and Georgia Ann Taburians except that Elias is to have a horse and the farm and mechanical tools before an equal division is made of said property. (giving him that amount over the others,) after the death or marriage of my said wife, All money, notes and accounts & other personal property that is not otherwise disposed of in this will is hereby given to my wife and children named in this item as the other personal property was given.

Item 2³ I direct ~~that~~ executors hereinafter named and appointed to pay all my just debts without any unnecessary delay.

Item 4⁸ I give, bequeath and devise to all my children to-wit: J.S. Taburians J.B. Taburians Fanny or Francis McCaha, Mary E Fann, Hester A. Norton Barbary Taburians, Delilah Taburians Elias Taburians, Georgia Ann Taburians. And the children of Adeline Leay, to-wit: Cynthia A. Caroline Martha Mary Lee Emily James William & Josiah Adelines children only representing one share, ^{and} of Lot of land Number 178. (120) acres of lot of land Number 181. Lot Number 184. (80) acres of lot Number 187. (120) acres of Lot Number 190 (100) acres of lot Number 218 (75) acres of lot Number 249. (120) acres of lot Number 141. All of said lots and parts of lots lying and being in Pickens County Wills 1854-1885 book 100

Second Section of said County, And should there be any other lands not named in this Will, they are to be disposed of as the lots in this Item,

The lands named in this Item may be divided in kind, if the Children can agree upon a division, if not. Then they (the Children) may sell at public or private sale upon such terms, and at such time, as they may agree upon, without any order from the Ordinary, and divide the proceeds equally.

My Executrix is to have nothing to do with the property in this Item, as Executrix only as she may represent minors

Item 5th I desire and direct that there be no appraisement upon my estate, nor Annual returns, as my property is already disposed of

Item 6th I desire and direct that the expenses in probating the Will and issuing letters testamentary be paid for out of the sale of lands in Item 4th before division is had.

Item 7th I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Executrix of this my last will and Testament with full power to employ such Counsel as she may think best to assist in carrying out this Will.
