I do therefore make this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all others made by me.

Item 1st. I will my Soul to God who gave it, and
my body to the dust, from which it was taken;
and that my body be buried in a decent manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition.

Item 2nd. I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid without delay by my executors hereinafter
mentioned and appointed, as I am unwilling
my estate should be delayed.

Item 3rd. I give, bequeath and devise, to my beloved
wife, Veressa Potts with whom I have lived eighteen
years, all my household, and kitchen furniture
also one third of my lands, to wit Lots Nos Forty
Eight (78) one hundred and thirty one (131) and
one hundred and thirty (130) all of said lots
of land being and being in the fourth lot, second
Section of Original Cherokee, now Pickens
County, containing four hundred and eighty (480)
acres; during her widowhood, or natural life,
and the said lots of land to remain unsold and
undivided, until my youngest child comes of age.
The names of my children, beginning at the eldest, to wit
Amelia L. Hill, the wife of David Hill, Christena L. Potts,
James C. Potts, John C. Potts, Elizabeth S. Potts,
Young M. Potts, and Alfred C. Potts; and when sold
my beloved wife to have one third of the proceeds, if

She that remains a widow; and at her death what remains to be equally divided between her children
 Trinit, Christian & Potts, James & Potts, John & Potts,
 Elizabeth Potts, Young & Potts, and Alfred & Potts,
 and also the third of what money I have or have had,
 the one by will, Thomas Potts, also money then due
 to the said Benjamin Pottsman; to be sold, and the
 proceeds equally divided among all my children.
 Provided she does not marry before the youngest
 child becomes of age, at the expiration of the time
 of said youngest child coming of age, to be sold
 and my beloved wife, to have for third part of the
 proceeds, and the remainder to be equally divided
 between all the children first mentioned.
 Item I do direct that all my personal property be
 sold forthwith

And I do hereby constitute and appoint Thomas
 Holcomb and Samuel G. as Executors of this
 my last will and testament
