not knowing how soon I may be called to leave
this world of sorrow and being desirous of
arranging my worldly affairs, so that there may
be no difficulty in the division and disposition
of the worldly affects, with which my Creator
has blessed me, do declare the following to be
my last Will and testament, hereby revoking
and declaring null and void, all other
Wills heretofore made by me, if any such
should be in existence,

Now first I will and bequeath to my daughter
Mary M. Powell, all the property of which I
may die seized and possessor of after my just
debts shall be paid. **Pierce County Wills 1872-1885**
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I frequently mentioned to my daughter, R. Powell
is as follows, sixty five acres of land, with
improvements upon it said land being part
of Lot 46, Forty Six in the (1) Ninth District
of Pierce County and State aforesaid. Also thirty
five acres of land, said thirty five acres being
part of Lot (1) Number One in the (1) Ninth
District of the County and State aforesaid. Also all
my stock and all other property belonging to me.
I wish it to be distinctly understood, that the reason
why I do not mention my other children in the
final disposition of my property is that I have
already advanced my said other children as
much if not more than their share would
amount to, if what they have received, and
what I have now with the advancement made
Mary M. Powell, was all put together, and an
equal division made between them all.

24th 1883.
