Allen Johnson
Will

I Allen Johnson of the County of Polk & State of Georgia being of Sound Mind and Memory and considering the uncertainty of this mortal & transitory life do therefore make certain publish and declare this to be my last will and testament that is to say First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the residue of my Estate real & personal I give bequeath & dispose of as follows to wit

1st I give and bequeath to Mary Davis (widow of Van Mc Davis) & to her bodily heirs Two Hundred fifty Dollars Cash in lot of land etc 54 fifty four in the 22nd Twenty Second Dist 3^d Section & also all my house hold furniture consisting of a bed furniture a chest & trunk &c

2nd Should I have any money on hand after paying for trouble & expenses of Daniel I desire that five Dollars Cash should be given each to J. F. Thomas & Sarah Thomas

3rd I make constitute & appoint Van Mc Davis agent in trust for his children or the children of Mary Davis in case said Mary Davis should die before the said Van Mc Davis

4th I desire that Van Mc Davis & J. F. Thomas shall see that I am decently buried in a plain stile & as early as convenient after buriall to have a Stone or Brick wall of one foot above the ground & a decent little house erected on said wall & covered over securely in order that my grave should be protected from the weather, for this service I desire that the said Van Mc Davis & J. F. Thomas should have & receive Three Dollars in specie which I shall leave for that purpose

In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name & attested my seal this 13th day of June 1875

The above written instrument was subscribed by the said Allen Johnson in our presence and acknowledged by him to each of us & at the same time published & declared the same instrument to be his last will & testament & we at the testators request in his presence have signed our names as witnesses hereto and written opposite our names our respective places of residence

McCall deposes & swears of the same that he saw said Allen Johnson sign & publish the same as his last will on the day & year then stated as recorded by him that he witnessed the same at his request in his presence & in the presence of the other witnesses that the same was voluntarily executed by him while he was of sound and disposing mind and memory
