Item 1st

It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of the effects of my Estate.

Item 2nd

It is also my Will and desire that after payment of all my just debts that the residue of my Estate both real and personal remain in possession of my beloved wife Susan Brooks during her lifetime and in event that she marries again then all my estate Real and personal be distributed equally alike among all my children to wit Alexander Miller Brooks Robert Henry and Harrison Chimes Brooks and my daughter Sarah Chimes Brooks and my daughter Mary Chimes Brooks.

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and then a like, and my beloved wife provided she marries again to take her third or fourth part according to her election

Item 3rd It is my further will and desire that my son Alexander Mills Brooks be sole Executor to this my last will and Testament and that he shall speedily carry my will into effect according to its stipulations

Item 4th It is further my will and desire that this my last will and Testament be carried out fully in every respect by my Executor avoiding any litigation and that should any difficulties arise concerning the estate among my children that these differences be decided by officers honest men, avoiding all law suits In Testimony whereof I Oliver Brooks have hereunto subscribed my hand and name and affixed my seal this the Thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and forty eight
