will

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen
I David D Heslop being of an advanced age but of sound mind & disposing memory
do make this my last will and testament as follows to wit
First I desire and direct that my body be buried in decent & christian like manner suitable to
my circumstances and condition in life and that all my just debts be paid without unnecessary
delay by my executor hereinafter named and appointed & I give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth D Heslop the following lots of land to wit One thousand and seventy six (1876) and
one thousand and seventy seven (1877) in the twenty first (21) District and third 3^d Section
in said county
Third I give and bequeath to my daughter Ellen D Simpson and the children borne of her body
the following lots of land to wit Sixteen hundred and forty seven (1847) and Eleven hundred and
forty five (1845) in the twenty first (21st) District and third (3^d) Section in said county
Fourth I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret Heslop all the balance of my property Real
personal and mixed and choses in action for and during her natural life and at her death to
be sold and out of the proceeds thereof my two daughters hereinafter named to wit
Elizabeth D Heslop and Ellen D Simpson first to have in their own right absolutely the sum of two hundred
dollars each and the balance of the proceeds of said sale to be equally divided between my other heirs
Fifth In the event my said daughter Ellen D Simpson shall depart this life without children I desire that
the property hereinafter bequeathed to her and the children borne of her body revert back to my estate and be
equally divided between my other heirs
Sixth I hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend William Hubbard as the executor of this my last
will and testament and revoke all former wills or wills heretofore made This 3rd day of Feb 1875
