 Polk County <sup>to</sup> that I must shortly depart from this world do make it right and proper both as respects myself and my family  
 that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me. I therefore make this day last  
 will and testament hereby revoking and cancelling all others heretofore made by me  
 Item First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition  
 Item Second I desire and direct that all my debts be paid without delay by my executors hereafter named as I am unwilling my creditors  
 if any, should be delayed of their just rights especially as there is no necessity for delay  
 Item Third I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth during her natural life or widow hood lot of land number 184  
 lying and being in the seventeenth District and 4<sup>th</sup> Section of Originally Cherokee now Polk County also one horse and wagon  
 and steers all my house hold and kitchen furniture all the corn and provisions on hand and all the crops made on the place this  
 year and all my stock of hogs  
 Item Fourth I desire that all the rest of my property both real and personal whatever and whatever it may be shall be sold and  
 all notes due for money and all ready money on hand shall be equally divided among all my children after paying my  
 just debts  
 Item Fifth I desire and direct at the death or marriage of my beloved wife Elizabeth that all the property herein bequeathed  
 to her shall be sold and the money arising therefrom shall be equally divided among all my children  
 Item Sixth I give and devise to Mrs. Berry's orphans the sum of Four Dollars  
 Item Seventh I constitute and appoint my worthy friends John J. Gerry and Henry A. Colmondous Executors to this my  
 last will and testament
