

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen

Polk County I Ephraim Thompson of the County and State aforesaid being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in the words following to wit

First I order and direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executors as soon as possible
Second having hitherto given my son Lucius E. Thompson Two Thousand Dollars, my daughter Mary E. Jones Two Thousand Dollars, my son James A. Thompson Two Thousand Dollars, my son Cory H. Thompson Two Thousand Dollars, my son Thomas J. Thompson One Thousand and ninety eight Dollars, my son William H. Thompson One Thousand Three hundred Dollars, my son Ephraim W. Thompson Three Hundred and fifty I now direct that the amount Two Thousand Dollars be made up to Thomas J. Ephraim W. and William H. counting the amount I have already given them

Third I direct that the remainder be equally divided between my above named children share and share alike, except that my grand son James A. Jones is to have the share of his mother

Fourth The following named lots of land together with whatever personal property may be on hand at my death or death of my wife, Etta Ann Thompson if she survives me in no event shall the personal property be sold disposed of or taken from my wife during her lifetime if she survives me

Fifth I Ordain and appoint my sons Lucius E. Thompson and Cory H. Thompson Executors of this my last will and testament
