I Ezekiah Leaster of the State of Georgia Polk County being of sound mind and memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while in strength do to do do and publish this my last will and testament lastly made all wills by me at any time hereafter made And first I Commit my soul to God who gave it And my body I desire it to be buried in the family burial ground And my worldly Estate I dispose of as follows

To my beloved wife Elizabeth Leaster I do will to her all of my Estate both real and personal To enjoy the same her and benefit for herself and for the support and education of my minor Children to wit James Leaster

Abner Leaster Ezekiah Leaster William Leaster and Jarmar Leaster First that my debts are to be paid And that my wife Elizabeth Leaster Carry out all of my Contracts and discharge any of my Estate that she may in her judgment think to be to her interest and to the interest of the Children I in my will that all of my White Land and the value of property that my son Elijah had one hundred head and clothing and one hundred and eighty pounds of pork And further desire that at the death of my beloved wife

Elizabeth Leaster that all of my Estate both real and personal be equally divided between my Children Susan Leaster Elijah Leaster James Leaster Abner Leaster Ezekiah Leaster William Leaster and Jarmar Leaster And I further appoint my wife Elizabeth Leaster the Executor of my Estate and Thomas C. Hampton the Executor of my Estate

In witness whereof I the said Ezekiah Leaster to this my last will Consenting of our Joint of paper have set my Hand and Seal this July 27th 1873
