Georgia } I Hugh Brewster of the County and State aforesaid do make and publish this my
Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me
at any time heretofore made and first I direct that my body be decently interred and that my funeral be
conducted in a manner corresponding with my estate and my situation in life and as to such worldly estate
as I am in possession of I dispose of the same as follows first I direct that all my debts and
funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as possible out of the first money that may be raised
from my estate also I will and bequeath to Phoebe McGlazier Five Hundred Dollars by the said
McGlazier paying to Jonathan O Brewster Fifty Dollars to Lewis Dickerson Five Hundred Dollars by
his paying to E Smith Fifty Dollars also Fifty Dollars to Mahala Marshall. To Shuff Brewster Five Hundred
Dollars by his paying to Margaret Warrick One Hundred Dollars. To Hugh B. McGlazier One Hundred Dollars
To Hugh B. Brewster One Negro Woman by the name Luey and also her Bodily Increase also one Hundred
Dollars for my funeral expenses after paying the foregoing bequests I will and bequeath to the person
at whose house I may die the balance of my effects and I hereby appoint Phoebe McGlazier my
Executor to carry into effect this my last will and Testament
Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us who have subscribed in the presence of each other this
thirteenth day of October in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty one The will and above bequestes given of the
above named person that have any thing killed or left in the above will removing without the state except
the same
