Pulch County } means as follows to wit,

Item 1st I bequeath to my son William E. West the following negroes together with their increase to wit,
Janna, Lewis, Jim, and Violet also all my stock and growing crop with which to pay my just debts
Item 2nd I bequeath to my son George W. West the following negroes to wit, Sinda and Child Susan also the money
together with the wages or hire of any of my negroes while working with him

Item 3rd I bequeath to my son James William E. West and George W. West my negro boy Dick to be equally divided between
them

Item 4th I appoint William E. James Trustee for James S. Lampton and to him as Trustee I bequeath my nego girl Anarchy
to have during the lifetime of James S. Lampton for her separate use & maintenance and after his death said
negro girl together with her increase to go to and be equally divided between the children of James S. Lampton
living at the time of his death

Item 5th I appoint William E. James Trustee for Susan E. Riggs and to him as Trustee I bequeath my nego girl Charlotte
to have during the lifetime of Susan E. Riggs for her separate use and maintenance and after her death
said nego girl together with her increase to go to and be equally divided between the children of Susan
E. Riggs living at the time of her death

Item 6th I appoint William E. James Trustee for Elizabeth A. H. Morrison and to him as Trustee I bequeath my nego
girl Charity to have during lifetime of Elizabeth A. H. Morrison for her separate use & maintenance and after
her death said nego girl together with her increase to go to and be equally divided between the children of Elizabeth
A. H. Morrison living at the time of her death

Item 7th My intention will and desire is that the legacies in the third fourth fifth & sixth items of this will
to my five son or children their mother be divided to the end that each of my said five son or children
may be made equal with each other

My will and desire is in the event that any of my said children in their will named Charles E. C. C.
leaving no child living at the time of his or her death then the legacy herein given to such decedent
shall go to and be equally divided between the brothers and sisters of such decedent and all child subject
to the same laws and trusts as is herein before specified
