State of Georgia
 The will of James B. Dempsey made and declared by him on the twenty eighth day of May 1881 in our presence under the following circumstances and in these words..

The said James being at his own house in Park County Georgia on the 28th twenty eighth day of May 1881 being near unto death in his last sickness from which he had suffered but a short while.. The undersigned were present waiting on him after calling on them to bear witness of what he should say.. declared as his last will the following words.. I wish my debts all paid.. then my two daughters to have all the balance of my property. Betsey A. Goggins & Camley A. Winborn. which is one lot of Land No (61) One hundred and sixty one in the Second District and fourth section of Park County State of Georgia. Camley A. Winborn to have the east half of said lot of Land. and Betsey A. Goggins to have the west half of said lot of Land and twenty dollars in money to make her equal in value lot of land to be divided north and south.. then if there be any of my effects left. after my debts is paid.. it to be equally divided between my said daughters and I also wish my friend A. J. Dempsey to be my Executor.. Soon after the speaking of these words in about nine days to wit on the sixth of June 1881 said James B. Dempsey died
