2nd Item. I desire that all of my just debts be paid without delay by Executor. I am unwilling that my
creditors should be delayed in their rights
3 Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Anna Heaton all that tract of land on which I
now live in the 18th Dist and 3^d Sect of Polk County together with all the appurtenances belonging
thereto and all or as much of the house hold and Kitchen furniture as she may desire to keep
also one cow said cow to be chosen by her for and during her natural life for her home and
her support and at her death all the same to be sold and the proceeds of said sale to be divided among
the hereinafter named legatees equally.
4th Item I desire that all of the property that I may be possessed with at my death both real and personal
not otherwise provided for in the 3^d item be sold and the proceeds equally divided among the herein
after named legatees James M. Heaton Malinda Campbell wife of J. P. Campbell Grindal Barber
wife of J. H. Barber Amanda Brumelow wife of W. W. Brumelow Martha A. McCarley wife of
J. H. McCarley Julia A. Heaton Mary Atkins wife of J. S. Atkins John R. Heaton Jr Joseph
Heaton James Heaton Benjamin J. Heaton and Sarah Meates wife of W. M. Meates
5th Item. I desire what I have given some of my children heretofore shall be taken out of their distri
butive share the amount to be settled by me and found in a Memorandum Book
in my possession
6th Item I appoint John R. Heaton and James Heaton to attend to the meeting of the farm and
Collecting of the rents and to pay the same over to my wife Mary Anna Heaton to be used
for her Support and Maintenance this October 6th 1883 John R. Heaton
