right title & interest in the same together with the appurtenances thereto belonging
free for her own use & benefit without let or hindrance during her natural
life then to pass to & become the property of her heirs by me in fee simple forever
Shorn & Shorn alike I also give bequeath & devise to my wife aforesaid

Shun & Shun alike I also give bequeath & devise to my wife aforesaid one work horse or its equivalent one milk cow & calf & whatever horse hold & fitted furniture I may be possessed of at my death free for her own use & benefit forever 3rd all the residue of my estate both real and personal not heretofore disposed of I desire & direct my Executors hereinafter appointed to sell and distribute first one hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to my Son Madison R. Hooper which is in lieu of a horse I had intended to give him then the residue as follows To Thomas L. Hooper John T. Hooper Madison R. Hooper Cynthia Dempsey my daughter & Martha Jane Southland or to the legal representatives of each or either of them equally Shun & Shun alike

4th I hereby appoint and constitute my wife Elizabeth Napper & George H. Watts to be my legally constituted Executors of this my last will & Testament
