Palk County I Letty Robt of the State and County aforesaid being advanced in years but of
sound disposing mind & memory do by these presents make certain last will and testament
and ~~Constitution~~ and establish this my last will and testament as follows
I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Caroline Robt she now resides with me
the freehold estate whereon I now reside consisting of lot of land etc twelve hundred
and Eighty 1280 in the third District and fourth Section & a vizignally known as
Palk County containing forty 40 acres more or less also I bequeath to the said Caroline
Robt my daughter as aforesaid my entire but clear personal property as also my house-
hold & kitchen furniture as I may be in the peaceable & lawful possession of at the time
of my death so much of the aforesaid personal property as house hold & kitchen furniture
as my beloved daughter Caroline may elect to be sold for the purpose of paying my
just debts as also funeral expenses The above bequests is hereby declared to be
to the exclusion of all my other children they having received in former gifts a
sufficiency to make them equal By virtue of these presents I authorize the aforesaid
legatee namely Caroline Robt at my death to take into her possession all the
aforesaid estate to be hers in fee simple after paying all my just debts and
funeral expenses as herein provided for In testimony whereof the said Letty Robt have
signed the within acknowledging the same to be my last will and testament hereby
revoking all other or former wills by me made in the presence of A B Jenkins
A Johnson & W Herge who on their part do testify that they were called upon by the
aforesaid Letty Robt as witnesses the above will was read and acknowledged by
the said Letty Robt to be her will and she signed the same in our presence we sincerely
believe that the said Letty Robt is of sound mind and memory Letty Robt Testor.
