all of my personal property which is situated lying and being in the Second District and fourth section of
Polk County and State of Georgia with all of my landed Estate with its tenements rights appurtenances
theretoments and premises with all personal property now lying & being in the Eighth Section of
Orange County Florida with all other lands with improvements in said County with personal property
therein And I do hereby give and bequeath all of my interest in the Estate with all rights and titles of
property or money inherited from my husband Benjamin Trotter deceased of the State of Indiana all of
which property and estate herein specified I well and bequeath to my son James M. Trotter during his life to be
Control enjoy sell and convey And at his death to be the property of his heirs who may survive him which
shall be equally divided among them And I do constitute and appoint my son James M. Trotter the
Executor of this my last will and testament who shall not be answerable to any one else for any act or
deed in any way connected with the disposition of my real or personal Estate money or property bonds
Bonds Mortgages or accounts owned or inherited which I herein bequeath to him And I do
hereby revoke all former wills by me at any time heretofore made or premises or declarations heretofore
made And I do declare this to be my last will and testament In witness whereof I have
signed my name and seal of office this 1st day of June 1891
