- Third I Give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Cornelia Wynn a negro boy named John and a
negro girl named Rhoe My will further is that the property that I have give to my daughter
Martha Cornelia Wynn be retained to her and to her children
- Fourth I Give and bequeath to my daughter Susan Ann Wynn a negro girl named Jane and her girl
child both mine and negro girl named Nancy and my child Watch My will further is that the
property that I have willed to my daughter Susan Ann Wynn be retained to her and to her children
- Fifth My will further is that a boy Stephen of yellow complexion and his wife Caroline be sold together
and a negro boy named Warren be sold also all three of said negroes to be sold on a credit of twelve
months with interest from date on said notes approved with good security My will further is that
all my estate both Real and personal that is not willed to any of my children be sold and the
money arising therefrom be applied to the payment of my just debts and if there should be a surplus
of money remaining after my debts are paid My will is that it be divided equally among my children
I do hereby appoint and constitute my Brother Solomon Wynn of this State and Samuel Morgan of the
State of South Carolina my Executors this twentieth day of February One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety one
