In the name of God Amen. I Robert L. Young of this State and County being of sound
and disposing mind and memory, and knowing that I must shortly depart this life
doe in right and proper both as respects myself and my family that I should make
a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me
I do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking and annulling all others
by me heretofore made

Art 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suitable to my Condition and Circumstances of life

Art 2nd

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid as early as practicable

Art 3rd I direct that my Land shall not be sold until my youngest Child now born or
that my hereafter be born shall arrive at the age of Twenty One Years, And when the youngest
Child shall become of age then and in that event the Land may be sold and the proceeds thereof
be equally divided between my legatees provided all the legatees to my Estate shall consent
Otherwise it shall remain undivided for the joint benefit of all my said legatees

Art 4th I direct that all my stock farming utensils and all other personal property of every
description shall remain upon the farm unsold except such as may not be needed for
the maintenance and Education of the family and carrying on the farm all personal
property is to be sold and the proceeds thereof equally divided between all my heirs
Whom and share a like when the Land shall be divided

Art 5th I direct that my property Real and personal shall be equally divided between my
Children now born and any child or children that may hereafter be born to me my wife
Charity Ann to have such interest as is herein after specified

Art 6th I direct that whenever there is any stock or other personal property not suitable for the
purpose for which it was intended ^{POK COUNTY PA} it may be sold and other property purchased
instead thereof

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Art 7th I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved wife Charity Ann an equal interest
with my Children in my said Estate for and during her natural life or widowhood
and in the event of her marriage all of her interest in my Estate shall cease determine
and revert to my lawfull heirs

Art 8th I direct that the advantages for Education shall be as nearly the same for each
of my Children with as little distinction as possible and the same as to their share

Art 9th I direct that a good Carriage & Harness be kept in good Repair for the use of
my family

Art 10th I give and bequeath to my son William L. Young my shot Gun, Trap Line
and Walking Stick

Art 11th I direct that my house be finished and painted and that a Dining Room & Cook
Room be built in rear of the dwelling and that the yard shall be well enclosed
with railings and a garden be enclosed in the same manner

Art 12th Whenever there may be any personal property not necessary for the support of
family and keeping up and carrying on the farm, the same may be sold and all the
money or loaned after provisions have been made for the Education of the Children
support of the family & necessary farm expenses I direct my Executors to put said
money at interest or invest it in property

Art 13th I direct that my Executor make annual returns to the Court of Ordway of
all his doings and doings in and about my said Estate

Art 14th I direct my Executor to take charge of my farm and manage it until the
settling of my said Estate attending to the Renting of the Land gathering and
& keeping the farm in Repair

Art 15th In case my estate shall be divided as herein mentioned
I desire my part and after said money shall be in the hands of the

My said Wife shall have Received from my Estate shall Receive to
my Children

Art 16th I Direct that My said Wife shall Receive from my Estate the same or
further Interest than has been herein expressed And it is my fully direct
that she shall not be allowed either Dower Or Grass allowance

Art 17th I hereby Constitute and appoint my brother James Young Executor
of my last Will and Testament

Art 18th If my Executor James Young should care to have Charge of my Estate
and a motion person be appointed to the said I direct that such person or persons
shall give Bond with good security for the faithful discharge of his Trust
