Body and disposing mind and memory, and knowing that I must shortly depart this life
desire it right and proper both as respects myself and my family that I should make
a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me
I do therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby reciting and containing all that
by you herefore made.

Art 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner
suited to my condition and circumstances of life.

Art 2nd

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid as early as practicable.

Art 3rd I direct that my land shall not be sold until my youngest child comes of age
that my daughter be born shall arrive at the age of Twenty One Years, And when the youngest
child shall come of age then and in that event the land may be sold, and the proceeds thereof
be equally divided between my legatees provided all the legatees to my Estate shall consent
otherwise it shall remain undivided for the joint benefit of all my said legatees.

Art 4th I direct that all my stock, farming utensils and all other personal property of every
description shall remain upon the farm unsorted except such as may not be wanted for
the maintenance and education of the family and carrying on the farm all personal
property to be sold and the proceeds thereof equally divided between all my legatees
there and there a like when the land shall be divided.

Art 5th I direct that my property Real and personal shall be equally divided between my
children now born and any child or children that may hereafter be born to me. They shall
Charity also to have such interest as is herein after specified.

Art 6th I direct that whenever there is any stock or other personal property not suitable for
purpose for which it was intended the same may be sold and other property purchased
instead thereof.

Art 7th I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved wife Charity, an equal interest
with my children in my said Estate for and during her Natural life or widowhood
and in the event of her marriage all of her interest in my Estate shall cease determine
and revert to my lawful heirs.

Art 8th I direct that the advantages for Education shall be as nearly the same for each
of my children with as little distinction as possible and the same as to their
Art 9th I direct that a good Barnage & Hornup be kept in good Repair for the use of
my family.

Art 10th I give and bequeath to my son William L. Young my old Gun, Bitter
and Walking Stick.

Art 11th I direct that my house be finished and painted and that a Dining Room & Cook
Room be built in rear of the dwelling and that the yard shall be well enclosed
with railings and a garden be enclosed in the same manner.

Art 12th Whenever there may be any personal property not necessary for the support of my
family and keeping up and carrying on the farm, the same may be sold and the
money so gained after provisions have been made for the Education of the children
support of the family & necessary farm expenses. I direct my Estate to put the
money at interest or invest it in property.

Art 13th I direct that my Executor make annual Returns to the Court of Probate
all his acts and doings in and about my said Estate.

Art 14th I direct my Executor to take charge of my farm and manage the
affairs of my said Estate attending to the tilling of the land, gathering and storing
& keeping the farm in Repair.

Art 15th In case my estate shall be divided as hereinafter
provided for, and an offshoot money be made in the division,

any Land Myself Shall leave Received from my Estate shall belong to
my Children

Art 16th I Direct that my said wife shall receive from my Estate the sum of
further interest there has been before computed And I further direct
that she shall not be allowed either Dower or Curtesy allowance

Art 17th I hereby constitute and appoint my brother James Young Executor
of my last Will and Testament

Art 18th If my Executor James Young Should cease to have charge of my Estate
and another person be appointed in his stead I direct that such person or persons
shall give bond with good security for the faithful discharge of his Trusts
