one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving them out of my Estate

4th I give and bequeath unto my son in Law John William who married my daughter Nancy McBrady
one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving them out of my Estate

5th I give and bequeath unto my son Robert McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving him out of my Estate

6th I give and bequeath unto the legal heirs of my son James McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving them out of my Estate

7th I give and bequeath unto my son Charles McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving him out of my Estate

8th I give and bequeath to my son in law John Wright who married my daughter Abigail McBrady one Dollar it being the
full amount I intend for them out of my Estate

9th I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving him out of my Estate

10th I give and bequeath unto my son John McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving him out of my Estate

11th I give and bequeath unto my son William McBrady one Dollar it being the full amount I intend giving him out of my Estate

12th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary McBrady all my Estate both real and personal not herebefore disposed
of to be disposed of as she may think proper for her own use

13th I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Mary McBrady my Executor to carry this my will into effect
herby revoking all other testaments by me made
