

Georgia In the presence of God Amen I Thomas A. Christie being of sound mind but weak in body
do make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st I direct and direct all my just debts to be paid as soon as practicable but I have contracted neither now

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth the use of all my property both real and personal
for her use and support during her life after paying before named debts.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Letitia Christie and my son George Christie all my real
and personal estate at the death of my beloved wife equally between them after deducting
amount sufficient to pay debts and other legacies named in my will.

Item 4th I direct that my executor furnish to each of my grand children, Whittie, Leland and Wags as they
become of age a good horse saddle and bridle each and give to my grand daughters Ida and Edna
one hundred dollars at their marriage or when they come of age.

Item 5th I give to my grand child Janie Sedell five hundred dollars at the time of her coming of age
after deducting any amount that may be paid out for her education if she is in life at that time
if she should die before she comes of age ^{Polk County Wills 1848-1891} the above amount to go to my son George and daughter Letitia

Item 6th I give to each of my beloved daughters Mary Brock and Sally Brock five dollars each and to my
beloved daughter Martha Christie five dollars and also to Dr. Sedell five dollars

Item 7th I make constitute and appoint my son George W. Christie my executor to carry into effect this
my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
to this instrument as my last will and testament this 11th day of December A.D. 1869.
