Polk County, State of Georgia, I, Ingraham of said State and County being in feeble health but of sound mind and disposing mind and memory knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me. I do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking and canceling all other writings before made.

First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it.

Secondly I desire and direct that all my just debt be paid as soon as practicable by my Executor herein after named and appointed.

Thirdly I give bequeath and direct to my beloved wife Helen M. Ingraham all my property of every kind whatever real personal or mixed.

Fourthly I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Helen M. Ingraham sole Executrix of this my last will and testament and it is my will that she be allowed to execute this my last will and testament without being required to give any bond for the faithful discharge of her duties this day the twenty eighth (28) of October One thousand eight hundred and forty four (1844) Thomas G. Ingraham (T.G.)
