Ingraham of said State and County being in good health but of declining and disposing mind and memory Knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me I do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling every by me heretofore made

First I desire and direct that my body be Buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it

Secondly I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid as soon as practicable by my Executors hereinafter named and appointed

Thirdly I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Helen M. Ingraham all my property of every kind whatever real personal or mixed

Fourthly I hereby constitute and appoint My beloved wife Helen M. Ingraham sole Executor of this my last will and testament And it is my will that she be allowed to execute this my last will and testament without being required to give any bond for the faithful discharge of her duties This day the twenty eighth (28th) July A.D. 1891 Nineteen Hundred and Seventy four (1891)
