The Last will and Testament of Urbane Cooper Hambro  
Rockmart Polk County Georgia August 30<sup>th</sup> in the Year of our Lord 1883

In the Name of God Amen I Urbane Cooper Hambro being of sound mind  
and Memory and being conscious that I must shortly die do make this my last  
will and testament revoking all others made by me previous to this date

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I want my body to have a christian burial out of the funds of my Estate  
Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I want all my honest debts paid

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I desire that my youngest son Thomas Joseph Hambro have a sufficient  
amount of my estate to educate and support him four more years

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I desire that my youngest daughter Mary Lula Hambro be supported out of my  
estate until she marries or die Provided she needs it. and that she have the  
further sum of Five hundred Dollars (\$500) to make her equal to the advances  
made the other Children when she is twenty one (21) years of age

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I desire that my youngest son Thomas Joseph Hambro have a support out  
of my estate until he is twenty one (21) years of age and that he have the further  
sum of Five hundred (\$500) dollars out of my Estate to make him equal to  
the advances made the other Children of my estate

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I desire that my beloved wife Sarah Jane Hambro have the remainder of  
my estate for her own use and benefit during her natural life or widowhood  
and that she have the right to make such disposition of it as she thinks  
but except in case she should marry and then in that case she shall receive  
but a child's portion which is five hundred (\$500) Dollars. The remainder  
to be equally divided <sup>Polk County Will 1847 1891</sup> among the heirs of my body that are living at that time

Item 7<sup>th</sup> I hereby appoint my beloved wife Sarah Jane Hambro Executor (without)  
security of this will and that she have right and power to execute to execute  
without due process of Law any other disposition of this estate may be  
had by the Unanimous Consent of all the legatees The Present Legatee
