The Last will and Testament of Urbane Cooper Hambro
Rockmont Palle County Georgia August 30th in the Year of our Lord 1883
In the Name of God Amen I Urbane Cooper Hambro being of Sound Mind
and Memory and being conscious that I must Shortly die do make this my last
will and testament revoking all others made by me previous to this date
Item 1st I want my body to have a christian burial out of the funds of my Estate
Item 2nd I want all my honest debts paid
Item 3rd I desire that my Youngest Son Thomas Joseph Hambro have a sufficient
amount of my estate to Educate and Support him four more years
Item 4th I desire that my Youngest daughter Mary Lula Hambro be supported out of my
estate until she marries or die Provided she needs it. And that she have the
further Sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) To make her equal to the advances
made the other Children when she is twenty one (21) years of age
Item 5th I desire that my Youngest Son Thomas Joseph Hambro have a Support out
of my estate until he is twenty one (21) years of age and that he have the further
Sum of Five hundred (\$500) dollars out of my Estate To make him equal To
the advances made the other Children of my estate
Item 6th I desire that my beloved wife Sarah Jane Hambro have the remainder of
my estate for her own use and benefit during her natural life or widowhood
and that she have the right to make such disposition of it as she thinks
but except in Case she should marry and then in that Case she shall receive
but a child's portion ^{Polk County Wills 1843-1891} which is five hundred (\$500) Dollars. The remainder
to be equally divided among the Children of my body that are living at that time
Item 7th I hereby appoint my beloved wife Sarah Jane Hambro Executor (without)
Security of this will and that she have right and power To Execute To Execute
without due process of Law Any other disposition of this Estate may be
had by the Unanimous Consent of all the legates The Present Legates
are - Hamier H. Rumble - William Benier Hambro - John Allen Hambro -
Mary Lula Hambro - Thomas Joseph Hambro - Sarah Jane Hambro
