In the name of God Amen

I William Drummond of the County of Polk & State of Georgia being of Sound Mind & memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail & transitory life do therefore Make & declare Publish and declare this to be my last will and testament that is to say first after all my lawful debts are paid & discharged the residue of my estate real & personal I give bequeath & dispose of as follows to wit

1st I give & bequeath to my daughter Emily Drummond a fractional lot of land No 213 & ten acres an lot No 914 or what is now in cultivation on said lot

2^d I give & bequeath to my daughter Cynthia Julia Stokes one Hundred fifty Dollars first money collected out of my Estate also a Sides Saddle or the Value of one in money worth from ten to Twelve Dollars

3^d I desire that my Executor at a reasonable time after my death to dispose of all my real and personal property & effects & also one fourth interest in Seventeen Hundred Dollars in notes now in the hands of my daughter Susan Ann Brooks after expenses & charges are paid to be

be equally divided share and share about between my five Children to wit:

Susan Ann Swicks Isabella Caroline Brannan Emily Drummonds Sarah Jane Morris
Syntha J. Stokes. I do wish I make Justice and appoint William Hagg of Polk County
& State of Georgia to be Executor of this my last will & testament. I further desire & direct my Executor
to obtain fifty Dollars out of Emily Drummonds Share and divide it among my said Children Share & Share
about. I further desire & direct my said Executor to have my remains decently buried in Christian
form & at the proper time to have suitable Terms Stews placed over my remains & also that of my
beloved wife. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 25th
day of May 1873
