Bolton County I William Hogg of the State and County, aforesaid being wise and
discreet in body and advanced in years but of sound mind and
disposing memory and knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of
death have thought proper in order to dispose of such worldly goods and chattels
as it has pleased God to endow me with to make and Ordain publish and establish
this my last will and testament

Item 1st I Consign my Soul to God who gave it and my body to its Mother earth to
be Buried by the Side of my deceased wife in a decent and Christian manner
charging and directing that all of my just debts be fully paid and discharged by
my heirs after named Executors

Item 2nd It is my will and direction that after my two sons Millard Hogg and
Abner Darden Hogg have each drawn their proportional share of
household furniture And after the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars
already paid to my daughter Mary Whitehead has been paid back to the
estate Or in some way legitimately accounted for as a part of her
interest in my estate Then it is my will and directed that all of
the property belonging to my estate be equally divided between my four
Children Martha E. West Millard Hogg Abner Darden Hogg
and Mary Whitehead And in the event of the death of my said daughter
Mary Whitehead leaving no other issue than her daughter Martha
Elizabeth Whitehead And in the event of the death of the said Martha
Elizabeth Whitehead during her minority or without issue Then the
portion of my estate set apart for her mother Mary Whitehead is to
revert to my estate Polk County Mills

children or their legal representatives

Item 3rd It is my will and direction that that part or tract of my landed estate
known as the home place and whereupon my dwelling house now stands
and the dwelling together with a portion of the land adjoining the same
be valued and appraised and that my daughter Martha have the refusal
of said place to the amount of her share or interest in my estate

Item 4th Finally I nominate appoint and constitute my two sons Millard Hogg
and Abner Darden Hogg Executors of this my last will and testament
enjoining upon them peace harmony and kindness to each other as well
as kindness and protection to their sisters hereby revoking and disannulling
any and all wills heretofore by me made In witness whereof I have
unto set my hand and affix my Seal this Dec 23rd 1878
