Polk County, the will and testament of said state and County being in a low state of health claim it right and proper to be as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property which a kind Providence has blessed me do therefore make this my last will and testament.

1st Item I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my condition and circumstances of life, my soul I trust shall return to god who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through and abounding of the blessed God and Saviour Jesus Christ.

2nd item I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay by my executor hereafter appointed, as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed in their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

3rd item I desire that my land to wit one thousand and twenty, one thousand and twenty one thousand and twenty two one thousand and sixty nine one thousand and twenty one thousand and ninety two and one thousand and ninety three remaine unsold and all other property goods and chattels necessary for the cultivation of farm and for the maintenance of the family to wit my wife Anna Ann my children to wit Thomas Jefferson, Mary Jane Julia Ann James William John Marion Henry McMullen Martha Ella during the minority of my youngest child Martha Ella, or the youngest living heir my wife and children to live according to widowhood and all my property to be controlled by my Executor and Ordinary of the County according to law and my will, and all the procedure made out what it takes to support my family to be sold and the money lent at interest, and all money ^{Polk County Wspt} at interest, and all goods and chattels and other property not necessary for keeping up this farm, and not necessary for the maintenance and comfort of the family to be sold and the money lent at interest, and when my youngest heir living becomes of twenty one years of age I desire that my property be sold and equally divided among all my lawful heirs as above named.

4th item I hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend Thomas J Thompson Executor of this my last will and testament this May the 17th 1869.
