Item 1st

I desire my soul to God who gave it.

Item 2nd

I desire and direct that all of my just debts be paid by my executors herein after mentioned with
Especially as there is no cause for delay.

Item 3rd

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Clegg my personal and real property whatsoever for her natural life or during her widowhood Except a sum sufficient to make John and Margaret equal with my children already provided for. And at the death of my said wife I desire and direct that whatever property there may be left after providing for John and Margaret be sold and given to my surviving children of living time if any should die having children then to them.

Item 4th

I appoint and nominate my son Andrew Clegg my executor to this my last will and Testament delivered and published before me this 5th day of April 1848.)
