Putnam County In the Name of God Amen I
Archibald McHenry of the State and
County aforesaid being sick & weak in body but of
perfect mind and memory, knowing that it is
appointed for all men ^{men} to die do make an a order
this my last will and testament that is first
of all I recommend my soul to god the hands of the
almighty who gave it and my body to the Earth to
be buried in a Christian like and decent manner
at the direction of my Executors

Item 1 I give and bequeath to my step son James M
Chambers my tract of land lying and being in the
County of Greene adjoining Turkey and others containing
two hundred acres more or less together with all my
stock of Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep that I have or shall have
also my Household Furniture therein belonging
and Plantation tools utensils also such negroes as I
shall choose to wit Fiddie Jubile Peter Pompey Eli
Jacob Sampson David Shelly to him and his heirs
forever I also give to the said James M Chambers
my tract of land lying in Hancock County
adjoining Hudson and others containing three
hundred and thirty acres more or less I also give
bequeath to the said James M Chambers my tract
of land in Columbia County adjoining Nelson and
others containing two hundred and fifty acres more
or less I give to the said James M Chambers
my tract of land lying in Polk County containing
two hundred two and one half acres
I also give to the said James M Chambers my plantation
whereon I now live lying in the County of Putnam contain
ing three hundred acres more or less together with all
my stock of every description Horses also Household
and Kitchen Furniture & plantation tools things belonging
also my fire arms Saddle & Saddle & Watch

Item 2 I do hereby nominate and appoint my step son
James M Chambers and my friend William E
Adams my Executors to this my last will & Testament
to witly Vannulling & Revoking all former ones
made by me, I Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal this 4th day of May 1824
