Georgia { Know all men by these presents that Charles Bradley being, very sick but in my proper mind and recollection do make up my last will and testament in the following manner that is to say, after all my just debts is paid
1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Bradley my present parcel of land adjoining Fritch, together with all other after her death to my beloved son John Bradley
2nd The land whereon my son William Bradley now lives it is my will that he shall keep as long as he sees cause to stay on the same household and other things including stock
3rd The remainder of my furniture to be kept together by my wife Elizabeth until her death to be equally divided between my three daughters Elizabeth, Mary & Abigail
4th It is my will that a sufficient quantity of the present year's crop to be sold by wife Elizabeth to discharge all my just debts
