Know all men by these presents that Charles Skaggs of the County State of Georgia being in an an infirm state of health though in sound mind do make and bequeath this my last will and Testament in the following manner

I give to my wife Laura Skaggs all the love, care and affection which I cherish her

I give to my daughter Polly a side board left her by her mother

I give to my son William a long shot gun now in Fayette

I wish my Landed Estate in the County of Fayette and Dooly to be sold and my just debts to be paid out of the money arising from the estate thing and the balance equally divided among my ^{lawful} heirs

It is my desire that my brother James Skaggs be appointed my Executor to this my last will and Testament and of all the property in my possession not named herein

I wish my stock of all kinds, Merchandise and personal Furniture to be sold and money Equally divided between my lawful heirs
