In the name of God Amen I David Robins of the County of
Putham and State of Georgia being weak in body but
sound in mind and memory, taking into view that it is
appointed to me to die do constitute and appoint this my
last will and Testament hereby disannulling and revoking all
former wills made by me. First I resign my body to its Mother
dust to be buried in a decent manner and my soul to God
that God it having a comfortable hope that he will take it
to himself. It is my desire that my Executors hereafter named
keep my estate together both real and personal and have the
business carried on the same as if I was living until my
child comes of age or marries and that they apply the
proceeds arising from the same to the payment of my debts
till all is paid off and after the debts are paid I leave
it with my Executors to apply the profits of the same as
they may think well be most to the interest of my wife
and children. In case my wife should marry

It is my design that she have a child's part of my Estate which is to be returned to my beloved children after her death and the heirs of their body equally

It is also my design that each of my children as they arrive at age or marry have out of my Estate three negroes viz. a young man & woman & boy or girl six or seven years of age with such stock and other necessaries as my Executors think my Estate will authorize them to give and I wish each child when they receive the above to give a Receipt for the same with a condition to refund back their proportionable part In case their should be a deficiency so that each child should be made equal

When my last child comes of age in case ^{my wife} continues a widow and is still living I wish the balance of my Estate to be kept as heretofore unless it is thought best by my wife and Executors to have a further division until her death or intermarriage and then to be equally divided between my children and the heirs of their body.

I give my Executors full power to sell any ^{sums of} ~~part~~ part of my Estate if they should think proper and apply the same as they think will be most to the interest of the Estate.

I wish my Executors to see that my children all receive a good english Education. I nominate and appoint John Robt of Hancock County William C Adams & Samuel H Roper Executors to this my last will Samuel H Roper not to act until he is twenty one years of age. Given under my hand this 26th day 1828
