In the Name of God Amen I Dorothy Smith of the County
of Putnam and State of Georgia being in good health and of sound
Mind and memory do make and publish this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form following
To First of all I Recommend my soul into the hands of God
My Creator and desire that my body be buried in a Christian
like manner and my worldly goods as follows

- 1 I Give and bequeath to my son Gattie Smith my Negro Man
Grove on Negro by Alfred to him and his heirs forever
- 2 I Give and bequeath to my daughter Charlotte one Negro
Woman Bessy if she should have any more from
this time before my death I Give and bequeath the same
to my son Gattie & his heirs forever
- 3 I Give and bequeath to my son Thane Smith one Negro
boy Edmund to him and his heirs forever, I also give
and bequeath to my son Joel Smith one Negro Girl
named Easter with all our Fattly food and Furniture to him
and his heirs forever, I hereby nominate and appoint
my son in Law John Read of the sole Executor of this my
Last Will and Testament hereby disavowing all other
Wills bequeaths or Gifts by me made and confirming
this and no other to be my last will and Testament

this my last Will and testament after my death I wish my body
to be decently buried returned to its mother dust
I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Gray my lands
and all my negroes & stock of every description plantation tools
household and kitchen furniture with the Residue of my
property during her natural life time After her death I
want my property distributed in the following manner viz
I Give and bequeath to my son John Gray my negro man Peter
I Give and bequeath to my son Thomas Gray my negro
woman Delly & Anna a Girl and a boy by the name of John
and my Girth Oxen and Cows I Give and bequeath unto my
daughter Elizabeth Millican a negro boy named Isaac which I
Gave off to her at her marriage I Give and bequeath unto my
daughter Nancy a negro Girl named Nancy which I gave
her marriage I Give and bequeath to my son William
Gray my negro man Stephen & boy named Peter my lands
to be equally divided between my son Thomas Millican Gray
with the Residue of my property I leave my son Thomas
William Gray my Executors in testimony whereof
I have affixed my hand and seal this 26th day of Decem-
ber in the year 1825
