House and kitchen furniture except the donation to my Grand
Daughter) My working tools of every description, My stock of
Hops, and works that I have, my Horse Bridle & Saddle
and my crop.

one of which is in Lu County Number One hundred & eighty four

and nineteenth article I wish to be possessed by my Grand Son Isaac W. Chismut son of said Daniel to whom I assign my right & title nominating & appointing said Daniel & heir to said Isaac. If he should die without a body heir I want the same. Having received the above named notes on Armon James for the purpose of taking out the plot & grant of said drawn Land, I wish my Executor to collect the same, and pay for the plot & grant of said three square of Land, and to deliver to Daniel Chismut the plot & grant for the within described tract for the use and benefit of his Son Isaac as herein expressed.

Georgia Putnam County In the name of God Amen, I John Allen a citizen of the County and State afore said being sick and weak of body but of a sound & disposing mind and memory do hereby make and ordain and establish this my last Will and Testament. First as to regards my body it is my request that it should be buried after my death in a decent and Christian like manner, and as to regards my worldly property which now belongs to me, I do bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner viz Item the first. It is my will and desire that my Negro boy Armistead should belong to my daughter Frances Allen and after her death that he should belong to her three Daughters Delpha and Lucy and my Negro Girl Iris I give and bequeath to my daughter Liza A. Allen but if she should die without an heir it is my will that the before named Negro girl Iris should then belong equally between the children of my son Leland Allen and the children of my daughter Frances Allen if the balance of my property after my death should not be sufficient to pay off all my debts then it is my will and desire that the Negroes named above viz Armistead and Iris should be held out until a sufficient
