

Green Perry Will

State of Georgia Putnam County

In the name of God Amen.

I Green Perry of the County and State aforesaid being of sound mind and perfect memory but in ill health do make and declare this to be my last will and testament and revoking all other former wills made and testaments made by me.

First it is my will that all my just debts be paid by my Executor out of the proceeds of the present will or with some of the debts due me.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto Helene wife Elizabeth A Perry all of my landed possessions in the County of Appling and State aforesaid on the ocean side with all its appurtenances also the following negroes Viz. old Aguin and his wife Charity and young Aguin, John, Pompey, Eliza, Maria, Malinda, Charles, China, Dick, Gilbert, Nancy, Harriet, Rachel, Nancy & Child George, Mason, Leroy, Phileas & George & their mores, also all my books, my household and kitchen furniture, with the linen, clothing and every thing appertaining thereto also Pork, corn, fodder, sufficient for the support of the hands and plantation above named for one year also two cows & calves, the three mules which my wife had at the time of an intermarriage the black man, my old domestic man, & the blackable John Filly, my small plantation waggon, the old yoke of oxen and half the plantation tools and utensils except the gear of my road wagon.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my brother Elijah B Perry the note which I have loaned him for five hundred and fifty four dollars and seventy eight Cents.

Fourthly after the payment of my debts I want the Balance of my property together with all the balance my money and jewels equally divided among my Brother and three of his wife of not to their child or children Viz. Elijah B Perry, Samuel Perry, Truett and Nancy Stanton. I call my Executor.

My Wife, Sufficient James M. Chambers to be my sole Executor.
