In the Name of God Amen I Jones Wymon of Putnam County Being Fully affected thus in My Common Mind, Knowing the Invalidity, what it is appointed here for all Men to do I do make this My last Will and Testament First I give My Soul to God the Author of My Existence and My body to the Dust from whence it came to be Entombed at the Discretion of My Executors and as to My worldly Goods I wish them Disposed of in the following Manner I Give I give I bequeath unto my dear wife Hannah Wymon all My goods & Chattels Land & Tenements during her life term or Widowhood and as My lawful Legatee comes of age I give unto them each one Hundred Dollars And after her Death or Widowhood then the above Estate to be Equally Divided among all My Legatee. Now I last I make and seal My last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set My hand & Seal & affixed My Seal this Tenth day of Oct. 1826 Eliza Chas. & I declared the presence of us and we in the presence of each other
