In the name of God Amen I Henry
Spivey of the County of Putnam and
State of Georgia being weak in body but sound in mind
taking into consideration that all men have to die do constitute
and make this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking
all former Wills made by me. First I resign my body
to my mother's care to be buried by my friends in a decent
manner and my soul to God who gave it
I give my negro man Sam to my Bro in law John
Hall; I leave my negro man Toney after the death of
mother to the care of my Bro in Law John Hall, who is
to hire him and pay him here annually to my Sister Polly
Parrish during his life and after her death if Toney
should live to go to her children. I give my Bro in Law
John Hall Five Hundred Dollars. I give my Bro
William Spivey all my Stock & Four Hundred Dollars
I give my Bro John Spivey Seven Hundred Dollars
I give my Bro Capt Spivey Four Hundred Dollars
I give my Mother Mary Spivey all my part of the crop
and Five Hundred Dollars. I leave Four Hundred
Dollars in the hands of Wm E. Adams to pay my debts and
to have my Father's mother and my own Grave enclosed
with Bricks. I leave Fifteen Hundred Dollars in the

Car of Richard Pace Jr. Deaneport and Mrs E. Adams
to be kept on Interest and the Interest to be equally
divided between the Church at Crooked Creek Philadelphia
for the support of the Gospel at those Churches. and I leave
it with those three men named each to appoint his successor
to the same at his death. so that the Interest of said
sum money be continued for that purpose while those
Churches continues. The legacy left in this to be collected
by my Executors and paid over as my notes fall due
I nominate and appoint Richard Pace Jr. Deaneport
+ Mrs E. Adams Executors to this my last Will
